Dipole antennas often are the easiest to build, and then turned into inverted V antennas by raising the center of the antennas up into the inverted V style. It's a good idea to have your antenna at least one half ($1/2$) wavelength of the antenna. one quarter ($1/4$) wave is the minimum height above ground for effective performance.
